◆ WHAT WE OFFER

Our editing services.

Different manuscripts require different levels of editorial attention, so we offer several services tailored to your book's needs. Pricing is scoped after a manuscript review.

Service	What it covers	Best for
Proofreading	Final correction of grammar, punctuation, spelling, and typos.	Manuscripts that are nearly ready for publication.
Copyediting & Proofreading	Sentence clarity, grammar correction, readability improvement, and language consistency.	Most manuscripts.
Developmental & Structural Editing	Chapter flow, structure, argument clarity, and organisation of ideas.	Early drafts or manuscripts needing deeper refinement.
Developmental + Copyediting	Structural refinement and line-level editing to improve clarity, flow, and overall readability.	Manuscripts needing comprehensive editorial support.

◆ HOW PRICING WORKS

Fair, consistent, transparent.

Because manuscripts can be formatted in different ways, we use a standard page system to ensure consistent pricing across every project. Here is how it works.

Metric	Standard
1 standard page	250 words
Page count calculation	Word count ÷ 250
Less than 10,000 words	Per-project pricing, not per page
Example: 15,000 words	15,000 ÷ 250 = 60 pages

Your project quote is calculated using your page count and the service rate that matches the depth of editing your manuscript needs. This method prevents formatting differences from affecting pricing.

If your manuscript is 10,000 words or less, it is priced as a short manuscript on a per-project basis to account for the full editorial review and preparation involved, regardless of length.

A formal quote with full pricing is provided after we review your manuscript.

◆ HOW WE WORK

Our editing process.

Working with Writerlize is structured, collaborative, and transparent. Here is what happens at every stage.

1	You share your manuscript or total word count with us.
2	We assess the manuscript and determine the level of editing needed.
3	We provide a formal quote and timeline.
4	Editing begins after deposit confirmation.
5	A preview copy of the edited manuscript is delivered for your review.
6	Final payment is completed, and the final files are released to you.

◆ AFTER EDITING

Preparing your book for print.

Once editing is complete, we can connect you with our trusted publishing partner to help you take your manuscript to the next stage. This service is optional, available on request, and supports the following.

Frequently asked questions.

Q. Do I really need professional editing?

Yes. Editing ensures your ideas are clearly communicated and your manuscript reads smoothly. Even experienced writers benefit from professional editorial review. A second set of expert eyes catches what familiarity hides.

Q. How long does editing usually take?

Most projects are completed within 10 to 15 business days, depending on manuscript length and editing depth. We confirm timelines clearly during the quote stage so you always know what to expect.

Q. Can shorter manuscripts still be edited?

Absolutely. No manuscript is too small. We price shorter manuscripts per project rather than by page to account for the full editorial review and preparation involved, regardless of length.

Q. Can editing be completed faster than your usual timeline?

Yes. We offer express editing services for authors working with tighter deadlines. Express rates apply, and details are confirmed at the quote stage.

Q. What happens after editing?
